WinAPE 2.0 Beta 2

First of all, you have to make sure that you have selected the "CPC464 with ParaDOS" profile in the WinAPE general settings.



After that, to load our game tape in WinAPE 2.0 you have to insert your cdt file by clicking into File/Tape/Show Tape Control. Then you click open and search for your CDT file.



Now in the Amstrad command prompt you have to write two commands. **Itape** (to make Amtrad read from the tape and not from the disk or from another source)

Run" (to start reading from the tape)

If you find it difficult to type that special chars into the Amstrad command

prompt, you can use the "Auto Type" option by right clicking into the screen/File/Auto type.After that, you will see the message "Press play and then press any key". At this moment, you have to click the "Play" button in the tape control and then, press any key in the keyboard. After that you will see the loading screen.

The procedure is very similar to WinAPE. We'll start by inserting our CDT file. To make it, you have to click in the tape icon in the right upper corner. The you have to click in the Stop/Eject button to select the CDT file.

Now in the Amstrad command prompt you have to write two commands. **Itape** (to make Amtrad read from the tape and not from the disk or from another source)

Run" (to start reading from the tape)

After that, you will see the message "Press play and then press any key". At this moment, you have to click the "Play" button in the tape control and then, press any key in the keyboard. After that you will see the loading screen.



Real Amstrad CPC646

To load your tape in a real Amstrad, you have to insert your tape in the tape slot. Make sure the tape is rewind. After that, you have to run in the command prompt:

Run" (to start reading from the tape)

After that, you will see the message "Press play and then press any key". At this moment, you have to click the "Play" button in the tape control and then, press any key in the keyboard. After that you will see the loading screen.



Compilation instructions:

This game has been developed using CPCtelera 1.5 from the Development branch, commit 2cff69f. It's fully recommended to compile it using the same version. Using a different version may end having unexpected behaviour or even not compiling at all.

You can find the repository in the following link https://github.com/lronaldo/cpctelera/tree/development.

To compile the game you just have to open a command shell in the root of the project and execute:

\$ make



You have to help the dinosaur to escape from the civilization to complete **Super Tongue Dino**. For this, you have to pass the levels reaching the door in each one.

With your tongue power, you can jump in the walls that you are licking. This will allow you to perform a lot of jumps and stunts on the walls. However, the spikes at some levels will force the player to calculate and perform accurate jumps.

While you are jumping, you will try avoid the animals. Some of them like a **bird** or a **slug** are going to get in your way to chasing or bothering you. The bird are going to bounce against the walls and can change its course, and the slug can swap its own gravity. But with the invisibility power you will be able to mislead the enemies that are following you. Nevertheless, you can only use it once in each level.






In the game you will never run out of lives, when you die the level will restart. But you have a **death counter** that is shown in the end of the game and in the pause screen. If you want to reset the game you just have to go back to the main menu

When you die at levels 10, 15 and 20 you will see how a plant eats the dinosaur. This is a reference to the game "Astro Marine Corps" of "Creep Soft".





You can press "M" to silence the sound of the game, although it's very cool and we don't recommend it;)

TIPS CONTROLS:


- First of all, we have to place ourselves in a gravity system (like the earth).
 This is important to know when we can jump and when we cannot jump:
 - For this reason, if we are on the "ground" we can jump only pressing the "Q" key (vertical jump).
 - For the other way, if we want to make a **horizontal jump**, we have to collision with a vertical platform at the same time we are jumping, so we need to **press two keys**, **"Q"** and **"O or P"**, It depends on where we want to jump. (same playability as "Super meat Boy").



TIPS CONTROLS:

- 2 After performing a horizontal jump, there are two options:
 - Continue pressing the key of movement ("O or P"), so the hero will collide again with the same platform.
 - Or, immediately after jumping, you can press the other movement key ("O or P") to move in the opposite direction. (better when you slide).
 Try to dominate the perfect jump!
- If you are **colliding** horizontally holding the key "O or P", the hero is going to slip and descend slower.
- About **invisibility**, is important to know that the difficulty of the game increases and the "intelligence" of the enemies too. this is the reason why after the level 38 you are going to need this ability to go unnoticed with enemies.

Remember, you can only use it one time each level.
