## HOW TO PLAY

In the top right corner, you will see the remaining amount of oxygen, which decreases over time. You must collect the air bubbles that appear to refill your oxygen tank. Be careful, as every time you get stung by a jellyfish, you will lose some oxygen, so try to avoid all the jellyfish.

# ENEMIES

There's a bunch of enemies that you will face off against. Here is a guide to get to know them better and be able to avoid them to reach the end:



These enemies are the basic ones. They move horizontally but not very quickly, and they are not very large. You will have time to think about what the next best move is.



These enemies move horizontally, but they do so quite quickly. Move away as you see them!



These are pretty slow, but they are also big. They will threaten many of the positions you can move into.



These ones can move diagonally. They are not a big threat if they are alone, but they tend to come in waves with other enemies of different types.



These little ones are the bullet jellyfish. They wait until they have a clear shot and launch at full speed. Don't stay in the path of the shot.



These enemies gradually approach you, while moving up and down. Try to move away from them as they get a little closer.



This is the most dangerous of the enemies in DiveJely. It's the boss of the final stage. It approaches you while moving up and down randomly. There is no advice we can give to avoid this enemy. Just, be quick and be patient.
